PHAZAR ANTENNA CORP RECEIVED PURCHASE ORDER

PHAZAR CORP, (Nasdaq: ANTP) announced today that Phazar Antenna Corp. in Mineral Wells, Texas, a wholly owned subsidiary, was recently awarded a purchase order in the approximate amount of \$512,000 for the manufacture of DAS (Distributed Antenna System) communication antennas for the carrier market in New York City, New York. The antennas, which will be installed on utility poles and street light supports, will enhance carrier voice quality and improve mobile coverage. The equipment will be manufactured at Antenna Products Corporation's plant in Mineral Wells, Texas and delivered in the next six months.

As the result of this order, the Company's combined backlog of orders as of February 25, 2008, was approximately \$3.6 million.
